



PICKLEBALL RULES

“Order on the Court”

1. In order to avoid conflict we have set these rules of open play.
2. Racquets should be placed on the floor in a left to right progression to determine who is next up to play.
3. If all four pickleball courts are being used, then all four players come off the court when they finish their game, and the next four who are waiting go in to play.
4. If there are 4 or more pickleball beginners, one open court shall be designated a court just for beginners.
5. Pickleball games are typically played to 11 and win by 2. However, in open play, if there are more than 8 people waiting, games will be played until 9 and win by 1. The purpose for this is to guarantee a set time when players will exit the court. Games played to 9 and win by 2 can linger on among equally matched players, sometimes ending up to playing to 11 or more.
